

Water Restrictions

Customers using potable water or well water to irrigate may water **once a week, before 8 a.m. or after 6 p.m.**, on the following days:

Thursdays, addresses ending in **odd numbers** or letters A through M.

Tuesdays, addresses ending in **even numbers** or letters N through Z.

Shrubs and flower beds may be hand watered and vehicles may be washed at any time.

Hoses must have shut-off nozzles.

New lawns and landscaping may be watered on any day of the week during a 30-day establishment period, beginning the day new plants are installed. Irrigation must be done before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m.

Customers using reclaimed water for irrigation have no restrictions on its use.

In Florida, watering in the heat of the day – usually between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. will cause most of the irrigation water to evaporate. Watering lawns too often causes root rot.
